House Pours

Al Verdi Pinot Grigio 2012, Emilia-Romagna, Italy • \$8.00 glass / \$19 bottle
Aromas of lemon, green apple. Light, crisp and dry. Very refreshing.

Casteggio Barbera 2011, Oltrepo Pavese, Italy • \$8.00 glass / \$19 bottle
Cherry, blackberry and dark plum. Soft on the palate. Slightly spicy on the finish.

Sparkling

Laluca Prosecco DOC, N/V, Veneto Italy • \$8.50 glass / \$20 bottle
Creamy Pear and Lemon Curd, Creamy off dry.

White and Pink

Lagana Sauvignon Blanc, 2014 Walla Walla, WA \$8.50 glass / \$20 bottle
Crisp and tropical with a nose of pineapple, mango and lime. Tropical flavors melt into fresh pear, peach and apricot. Smooth finish of peach, lemon and lime. 100% Sauvignon Blanc sourced from the east bank of the Columbia River.

Les Jamelles Chardonnay, 2014 France \$8.50 glass / \$20 bottle
Aromas of apricots, pears and green apples, walnuts, hazelnuts and a hint of white flowers with a buttery finish. It has subtle and well-integrated notes of vanilla oak, combined with a slightly lemony note.

Linen, Dry Riesling, 2016 Yakima Valley • \$8.50 glass / \$20 bottle
This dry Riesling was slow fermented on yeast cultivated from Alsace, France. Lovely aromas of honeysuckle, peach, rose and stone. This dry wine fills the mouth, giving way to bright apricot, papaya and pineapple flavors.

Isle Saint Pierre, Rose Wine Mediterranee, 2018 France • \$8.50 glass / \$20 bottle
A beautiful southern French Rose from a vineyard positioned on an island at the base of the Rhone River.

Red

Forgeron Blacksmith Merlot, 2013 Washington • \$9 glass / \$25 bottle

A moderately aromatic wine with spice, cedar, and red currant. The palate is broad with soft tannins and silky fruit flavors. Finishes a bit tart. Boushey, Alder Ridge, Lonesome Spring Range, and Ash Hollow. Aged in French oak (30% new)

Farmhouse Red Blend, NV, Forest Grove \$9 glass / \$25 bottle

A blend of Bordeaux, Spanish and Burgundian Varietals.

Altos Las Hormigas Malbec 2012, Mendoza Argentina • \$9 glass / \$25 bottle

Classic Argentinian Malbec. Cool, smoky, red and black fruits. Fragrant and silky.

David Hill Estate Pinot Noir, 2015 Willamette Valley • \$9 glass / \$25 bottle

A bright aroma of red fruit, showing structured acidity in the mid palate with finishing notes of almond and truffle.

Windy Canyon Cabernet Sauvignon 2017 Walla Walla \$9 glass / \$25 bottle

Dark and rich berry flavors, a mild acidity and a big red juicy finish make this wine a fun one to share with friends or enjoy a glass to yourself.
